How to Apply

1. Complete the application form and essay and submit it directly through our website. The essay should be no more than 500 words and explain why you would like to be considered for the Rees Scholarship and how the scholarship will help you in your career. The essay should also demonstrate educational potential based on prior education or work history.

2. Request two electronic letters of recommendation from present or past employers, present or former teachers, or other professionals. Request that the letters are sent directly to ReesApplications@ahrinet.org. Additionally, he or she should do the following:

- **Type the recommendation letter on letterhead**
- Indicate how he or she knows you
- Explain why you should receive the Rees Scholarship

We cannot accept recommendations that are written for other purposes. (e.g., job application or school entrance)

3. Mail your official sealed transcript (from high school, college, or trade school), or ask the school to send it directly.

4. Send a copy of your Alien Registration Card and letter stating your intent to become a United States citizen to ReesApplications@ahrinet.org, if applicable.
